

# SPRING CONFERENCE 2024

16 - 18 May 2024 Derry, Northern Ireland





### **Dear friends and Avrio colleagues,**

May I give you a personal invitation to the Avrio 16th -19th May 2024 Conference in Derry - Londonderry, Northern Ireland – my hometown – for what will be my last conference as President of Avrio Advocati.

The themes for the conference will be:

- · Net Zero and what it means for lawyers and our clients;
- · Data where it's going and what all lawyers need to know;
- · What non-family lawyers need to know when their clients tell you they are getting divorced;
- The economic leverage of Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland post-Brexit;
- · How to manage our businesses more effectively.

Derry (which is what the city is generally called) has sat in the political cross-roads of Irish history for 400 years, and as the celebrated comedy series "Derry Girls" suggests, to a large extent still sits there. But real life prevails, and, as a professional lawyer, the challenge of post-conflict civic society to rebuild economic innovation and social cohesion that is fit for the modern multi-identity and international world is a motivating and energising environment to work within. Especially when hope is in short supply generally in the world right now. It is my hope that you will experience some of this motivation and energy at this conference.

### How to get to Derry:

- If you are flying into Ireland from beyond the UK, the best way to get to Derry is to fly through Heathrow. There are three flights daily from Heathrow Terminal 2 directly to City of Derry Airport; the carrier is Loganair (www.loganair.co.uk). Then simply get a taxi to the hotel (www.bishopsgatehotelderry.com).
- The second-best airport to fly to is Belfast International Airport. There are hourly buses directly to Derry, which takes about 75 minutes. The bus company is Aircoach (www.aircoach.ie). Alternatively you could hire a car there.
- There is a second airport in Belfast, called the George Best Belfast City Airport. There is no public transport that goes directly to Derry from the airport, so your choices are either to get a taxi from the airport to Lanyon Place railway station in Belfast and take the train to Derry (which takes two hours), or to hire a car.
- Flying into Dublin Airport: whilst Dublin Airport is very well connected internationally, getting from Dublin Airport to Derry is something of a challenge, as there is not yet a train link or a direct motorway (albeit it is planned). There is two direct bus services Aircoach (www.aircoach.ie) and Ulsterbus (www.translink.co.uk), both of which would need to be booked in advance and takes 4.5 hours, or alternatively you could hire a car.

Karen and I, and our full team, very much look forward to welcoming you.
